## PROJECT PRESENTATION

Generative AI has rapidly reshaped the training landscape.

It impacts trainers' activities and learners' relationship with knowledge by supporting (and sometimes disrupting) cognitive processes.

With an increasing number of AI tools and services available, training organisations need to understand the stakes, evaluate impacts, and get insights of experience-based choices.

TELAİS aims to strengthen AI adoption in training through a structured, practical, and evidence-based approach.


## PROJECT OBJECTIVES

TELAİS project aims to improve the teaching practices of trainers and the learning practices of trainees with AI tools by :


- Developing **shared European expertise content** on the use of AI for training,
- Identifying and sharing **good practices** of AI by trainers and learners, analysed across the 5 partner countries,
- Organising and evaluating **real experimentations** with pioneering trainers and volunteer trainees in each country.

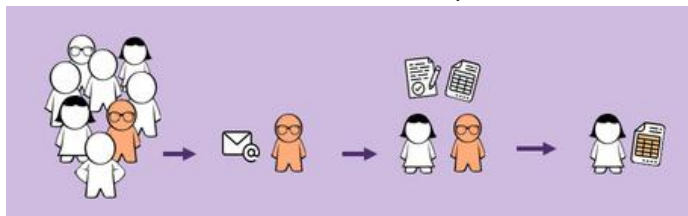

# What's New : From TELAIS Project Vision to Action

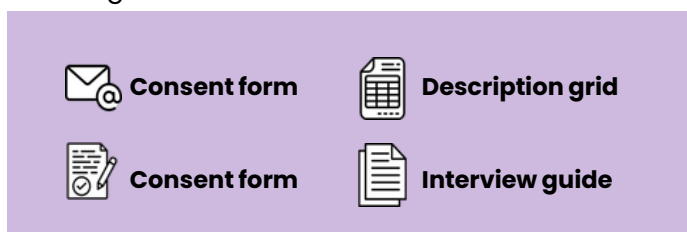
## SEARCH OF GOOD AI PRACTICES

The project is based on research into and the sharing of best practices in the use of Artificial Intelligence in training. This involves an intensive research within each partner's network and a coherent and consistent research process.



Identification of pioneer trainers/actors → Invitation email for the interview → Pioneer trainers/actors interview → Report, translation, analysis

In order to prepare the search, the partners have agreed on the workflow below and the use of the following documents :



All partners are currently identifying trainers, training professionals and pioneering learners who are using AI in their training and organising interviews.

Each partner is using a variety of methods to identify these pioneers : surveys, personal contacts, calls for contributions, social media searches,...

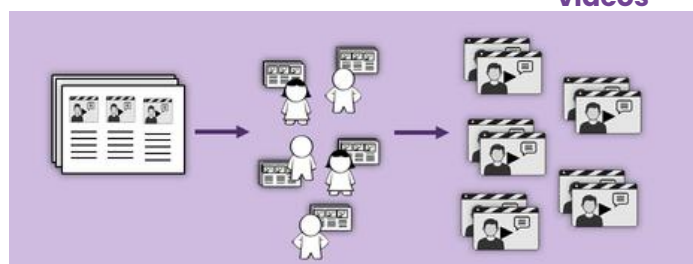
## CREATION OF EDUCATIONAL VIDEOS
